Amstelveen, The Netherlands, 29 January, 2008: Canon today refreshes its *i*-SENSYS range with the *i*-SENSYS MF-4270, a network-ready desktop laser multifunctional offering print, copy, fax and colour scan capabilities. Replacing the MF5770, the *i*-SENSYS MF-4270 adds a built-in duplex unit for double-sided printing, shorter warm-up time and a class-leading first copy out time of just 8.6 seconds. Sporting an exceptionally compact design with a stylish deep black finish, it offers a 20ppm/cpm print speed and built-in network connectivity – making it an ideal solution for the busy small office.

- Up to 1200x600dpi print quality

Double-sided printing

Saving time and paper costs while reducing the impact on the environment, built-in auto-duplexing allows printing on both sides of a single sheet of paper. Users can also employ the 35-page Automatic Document Feeder (ADF) to copy a batch of

single-sided pages and output as professional-looking double-sided copies. The ADF can also be used to scan in large fax and scan jobs.

High speed, high quality

Producing crisp, 1200x600dpi resolution prints at a speed of 20ppm, the *i*-SENSYS MF-4270 offers a compelling mix of speed and quality. With a warm-up time of just 10 seconds from power on, it offers the responsiveness needed by small office users. Canon's On-Demand Fixing technology enables a first copy out time of 8.6 seconds and a Quick First-Print – important for businesses that frequently print and copy small jobs.

Stylish & compact

The *i*-SENSYS MF-4270's compact footprint makes it ideal for offices where space is limited. One of the smallest laser all-in-ones in its class, it fits neatly onto the desktop. A stylish finish in deep black complements contemporary office designs.

Network ready

A built-in network interface port allows for easy integration with an existing peer-to-peer or small office network. The supplied NetSpot Device Installer software ensures quick, hassle-free setup. Users and network administrators can gain access to the device via the Remote User Interface, using a standard web browser.

Faxing and scanning

Canon's high speed Super G3 fax modem helps to keep costs down with a minimum transmission time of just 3 seconds per page. A large 256MB fax memory offers the advantage of storing incoming faxes if paper or toner runs out, as well as improving the workflow of outgoing faxes. For added efficiency, 7 one-touch speed dials and 100 coded speed dials can be programmed into the control panel. Quality is assured with UHQ (Ultra High Quality) Imaging technology, which enables faxing of documents containing diagrams, photos or text with minimal loss of detail.

The *i*-SENSYS MF-4270 provides full colour scanning at up to 9600 x 9600 dpi resolution. Documents can be scanned and saved in a variety of formats including direct to PDF with the MF Toolbox, which combines advanced functionality with simple operation.

Energy efficient, environmentally friendly

Easy on costs and the environment, the *i*-SENSYS MF-4270 requires just 3W of power in Energy Save mode. Operation is quiet and virtually no ozone emissions are generated. Additionally, Authentic Laser Cartridges for *i*-SENSYS are fully recyclable via Canon's own Cartridge Recycling Programme.
